Parents' Evenings

The annual meetings for you to discuss your children's progress with their teachers are scheduled for the second half of term. Appointment booking sheets will be on display from 22nd February. This year there is only one evening scheduled for Class One. If you are unable to make an appointment on this date please speak to Mrs Welden.

Although the annual meetings are important please remember that you are always encouraged to speak to teachers about any issues of concern as they arise and to keep us informed about your children's progress out of school. Teachers are usually available before and after school (and if they are busy they will always be happy to make an appointment to see you).

Uniform

Please make sure all items of school uniform, including PE kit, are clearly named. (Labels do need to be regularly checked as they fade in the wash!). It is easy to ensure that named articles are returned to the right child – if they are not named it is sometimes impossible.

PE Kit

Children do need to have their PE kit in school every day. In cold weather it is also sensible to have jogging bottoms to wear over shorts. Gloves and hats can also be worn in very cold weather.

Water Bottles

Don't forget that water bottles with a sports top are on sale (£1.20) from the office. Every child does need to have a water bottle in school.
